Premium tests are for the Passport to Safety for Supervisor Test, which normally retails for \$44.95 each. Tests provided free with your employer membership provide pin numbers and passwords, but do not include Passport to Safety wallet cards. Wallet cards are included when you buy additional or new lifetime Passport to Safety youth memberships/challenges for \$9.00 each plus applicable taxes and delivery*
